GRAPE VARIETIES

Aragonez, Syrah & Trincadeira

SOIL TYPE

Poor litholitic soil with a clay/sand/loam texture over granite.

VITICULTURE

Grapes harvested mechanically at dawn and destemmed in the vineyard.

VINIFICATION

Skin contact during soft and progressive pressing. Pre-fermentative clarification in order to obtain a clean must with clean aromas and a healthy fermentation. Fermentation in stainless steel vats at low temperatures and aging in fine lees with constant battonage, with 20% of the blend passing through used white wine barrels for 6 months.

TASTING NOTE

Blend of Aragonez, Trincadeira and Syrah resulting from a selection of vineyards located in the north of Alentejo and with greater acidity. This wine has orange brick tones, evident fruit aromas and light vanilla notes making it a rose ideal for pairing with more elaborate dishes. The presence of oak is undoubtedly what makes this rose more complex and ready to accompany a structured meal.
